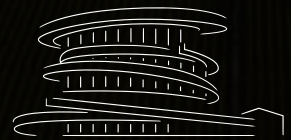

The Cité des Climats et vins de Bourgogne is a network of three wine tourism sites, located in three of Bourgogne's emblematic towns.

In Chablis, Beaune and Mâcon, each site promises a fun and exciting discovery of the history, heritage and unique cultural practices that have influenced viticulture around the world. In the wake of UNESCO's inclusion of Bourgogne's vineyard Climats on the world heritage list, the Cité aims to be an open door to the vineyards that surround it.

Barely 4 months after opening, the Cité was voted "best wine museum in Europe" by Iter Vitis - Chemin de la vigne et du vin.

The Cité, a unique sensory experience that is accessible to all!

The Cité is here for everyone: amateurs, novices, enthusiasts and the curious! Whether you're on your own, with friends or family; from France or further afield; part of a school group or a corporate visitor: all are welcomed with open arms at the Cité des Climats et vins de Bourgogne.

Street Art is coming to the Cité des Climats et vins de Bourgogne!

In 2020, the Appartelier gallery asked French street artists to create works based around the theme of wine.

Previously delayed by the Covid lockdowns, the exhibition will finally take place in spring 2024 within the Cité des Climats et vins de Bourgogne in Beaune.

This exhibition and sale will present around thirty works, bringing together sculptures, canvases, panels, small and large formats.

In addition to the many activities and events dedicated to them, kids benefit from a specially designed visitor trail throughout the year, brought to life by cabottes or cadoles (small wine-growers' huts) that reveal **fun multi-sensory activities** based around the history of Bourgogne's vineyards.

CULTURAL ACTIVITIES BASED AROUND WINE

The Cité has set itself the challenge of pairing wines with cultural activities. A new approach to tempt those looking for originality: **Wine and Perfume, Wine and Flowers, Wine and Sophrology, Wine and Art.** These activities are offered from May to October.

Escape game :

To attract teenagers and young adults, the Cité has conceived a special escape game based around vineyards and the world of wine. Activity offered from July.

ORIENTATION TABLES AT THE BELVEDERE IN BEAUNE

Panoramic view of the vineyard slopes from a height of 20 metres. Several orientation tables will allow visitors to orient themselves and identify the different perspectives of the wine landscape (vineyards, villages and even some specific Climats).

It offers a wide range of workshops, courses, and training; teaching you how to taste, understand the notion of terroirs, discover the different wine appellations, and to pair food with wine...

Founded in 1974 by the Interprofession des Vins de Bourgogne (BIVB), the École des Vins de Bourgogne has acquired real expertise in oenological training. It reveals every corner of wine-growing Bourgogne, from the Regional appellations to the legendary Grand Crus. Every year, thousands of students, from novices to professionals, attend its training, courses, or workshops all over Bourgogne and throughout France.



Its familiarity with key players in the wine industry (winegrowers, merchants, coopers, restaurateurs, etc.) gives it a unique insider's perspective, allowing it to offer services of the highest quality. In November 2022, the École des Vins de Bourgogne joined forces with the Cité des Climats et vins de Bourgogne, which now benefits from its expertise and its 50 years of experience.



You will also find the Ecole des Vins de Bourgogne in Dijon, at the heart of the Cité Internationale de la Gastronomie et du Vin, where you can take part in a unique 100% immersive tasting experience!

TASTING WORKSHOPS

Themed workshops are organised every day: the art of tasting, food and wine pairing, the sommelier's tips.

OENOLOGY CLASSES

TRAINING COURSES

Taster's Certificate: 3 days of training, teaching sensory analysis and tasting methodology. Open to informed amateurs and professionals.

The Professional Certificate in Sensory Analysis (CAPS): 11-day training course, Qualiopi certified, designed to optimise the performance of professionals, giving them the means to evaluate wines based on objective characteristics and contribute to improving the quality of Bourgogne wines. Open to professionals and people looking to work in this field.

DISCOVERY DAY

IN THE HEART OF WINE-GROWING BOURGOGNE

An introductory day that combines learning and the pleasure of tasting with that of discovering the vineyards and the heritage of the Côte de Nuits.

Learn how to view, smell and taste white and red wines and identify their aromas. How to keep and serve wines and food pairing are also covered. After a tasting lunch, the afternoon is devoted to discovering the vineyards with a study of the landscape in the Grand Crus of the Côte de Nuits, a guided tour of the legendary Château du Clos de Vougeot, and a visit to a wine estate with tutored tasting.

The bar à vins in Beaune, located on the 4th floor of the Cité des Climats et vins de Bourgogne, invites you to enjoy a unique experience with breathtaking views of the vineyard slopes.

You will be able to savour exquisite dishes designed to highlight the richness and diversity of the region's wines. The possibilities are endless thanks to the à la carte food and wine pairings, 3, 4 or 5, pairings, sweet and savoury, the choice is yours! This menu is designed to evolve with the seasons. To complete the offering, the bar serves staple dishes such as charcuterie/cheese tasting boards all year round.

But that's not all! Every month a themed evening is organised; Friday evening dinners offer a subtle marriage of Bourgogne wines and world cuisine, alternating with Thursday evening after-work events, animated by different entertainment every month.



LE PONTI'BAR

The Pont'Bar in Chablis offers light bites throughout the day accompanied by a selection of Bourgogne wines. It also organises themed after-work events and Sunday lunches prepared by a chef.



LE PRESS'BAR

Discover our selection of Bourgogne wines in Mâcon, either by the glass or by the bottle, which is regularly updated to accompany various tasting boards. As in Beaune and Chablis, thematic after-work events will be organised throughout the year.

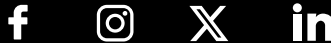

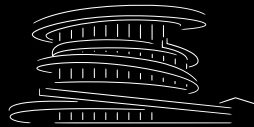

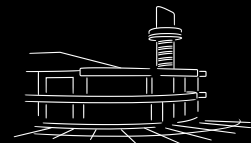
